Ultimate in pampering should look no further than the Valmont Spa in the Plaza Athénée. The treatment rooms used to be hotel suites, so

each has its own changing room and bathroom, along with a heated bed with high-thread-count linens. I chose the Vitality of the Glaciers treatment (\$350), which includes a 25-minute facial massage that uses the new Prime Renewing Pack mask. With ingredients like "triple DNA" and "liposome RNA," it sounded deeply scientific. But it helped me achieve a pretty

straightforward version of glowing skin—the kind you normally get only after skiing for an entire day.

The (Spa) Doctor Is In > ANT TO CLEAR YOUR MERIDIANS AND look younger in the process? Book the Antidote facial (\$750) at Shellie Goldstein Acupuncture. This treatment, from acupuncturist Shellie Goldstein and herbalist Daniela Turley, has two parts: a 60-minute consultation (for part of it I held on to a metal rod that measured imbalances in my meridians), and a 105-minute facial from Shellie that combined a skin-cleansing microcurrent treatment and acupuncture. I left with a bag full of products, all formulated to my personal needs. I've already scheduled follow-up

appointments, and, yes, my internal energy feels much more balanced.

F YOU'RE FEELING ADVENTUROUS, TRY A RECENT BRITISH import, Lush Spa. The upstairs treatment space evokes the British countryside, and the consultation area seems to have been modeled on a fairy godmother's house. I opted for the Synesthesia treatment (\$230), which was designed by one of the founders to produce interconnection among the five senses. The massage aimed to unite touch, sound, and smell; during
